Eligibility: 1. Active practitioners in the Asia Oceania Region (excluding Japan).
 2. Foreign Residents in Japan affiliated with a local federation of the All Nippon Kyudo Federation.
 3. Members of countries affiliated with the International Kyudo Federation. For those who do not fall under 1 or 2 and who are not from an affiliate country of IKYF, consultation is required.

Participation Fee:

JPY13,000 per person (Seminar – JPY10,300 Reception – JPY2,700)
 - Application to the Provisional Chuo Shinsa will require a shinsa examination fee to be paid separately from above.
 - All transportation costs to the venue (including plane tickets), accommodations during the duration of the seminar, and all meals are the responsibility of the participant.
